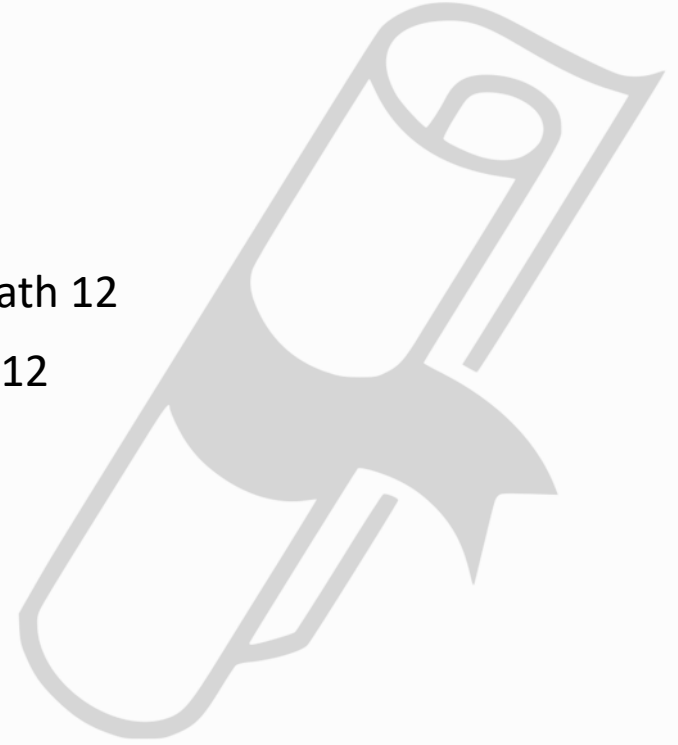
- 1) High school Graduation
- 2) Apply before the stated deadline
- 3) Personal Profile
- 4) English 12
- 5) 5+ additional academic courses (variable, but recommended)
 - Institution-specific (min grades in certain subjects)
 - Program specific (completion of specific 11 and 12 subjects eg. Faculty of Science or Engineering)
- 6) Competitive G.P.A. (AVERAGE) based on
 - English 12 and other required courses depending on program

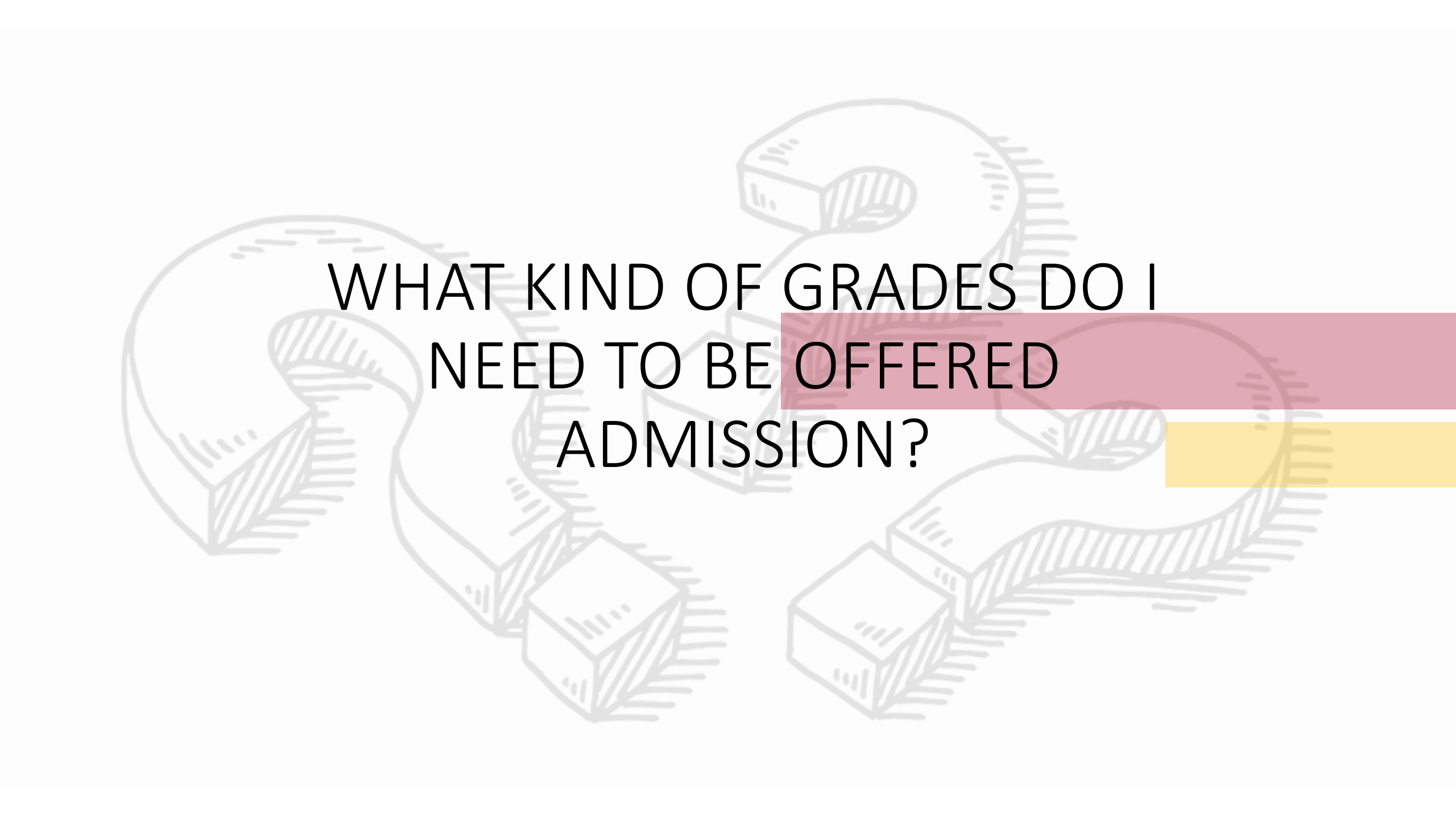

UNIVERSITY ADMISSION AVERAGES

- Each sets its own minimum grades
- Minimum vs. Competitive
- Competitiveness fluctuates
- 67% to 70% is generally the **minimum** to **apply** to an institution
- Grade 11 vs. Grade 12
- Hacks?
- There is no formula or guarantee

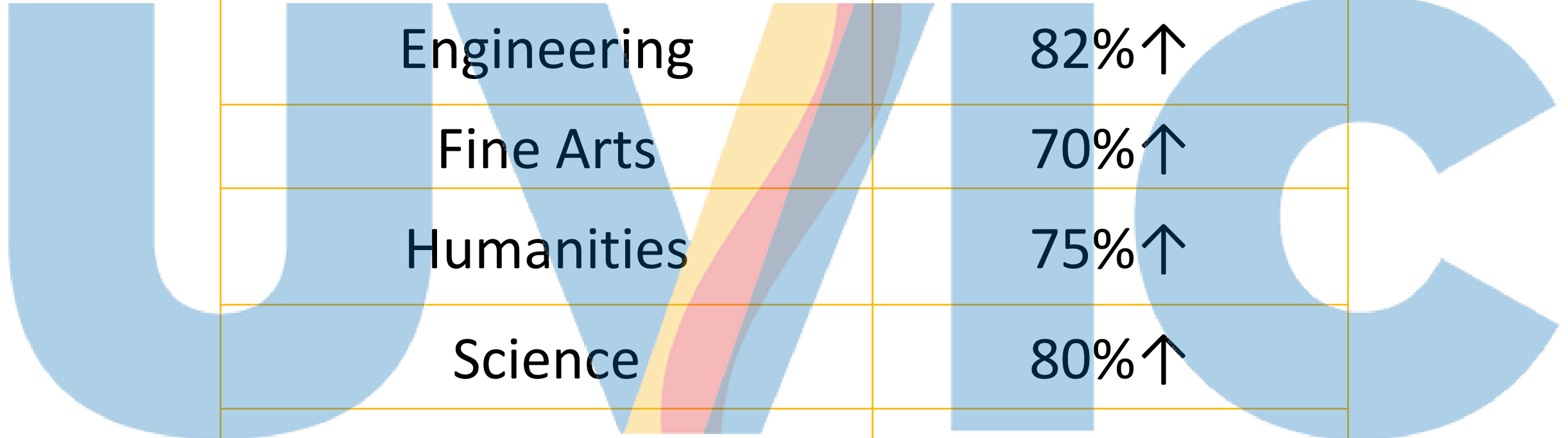

APPLICATION PROCESS

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Apply to multiple schools
 - keep options open
 - consider a college transfer
 - many programs are very competitive
- Applications require a fee for processing which is non-refundable
- Many Provinces require students to apply through an application service i.e.,

WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY?

- Demographic information
 - Name, PEN#, phone number, etc.
 - Knowledge or record of grade 11 & 12 final grades and a list of currently enrolled in Grade 12 subjects
 - A formal transcript is not required when initially applying to most institutions
 - If required, students can download a copy from the Ministry website using their BCEID. For a more up-to-date copy, student can order from the office for a small fee.

STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS

- Register to the **StudentTranscripts Service** (STS) website. This is an online application for students to view their school marks, scholarships and transcript, and send transcripts electronically to Post-Secondary Institutions.
 - Go to the Ministry of Education's **Transcripts and Certificate website** at <http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca>. You'll need your PEN#, Full legal name, DOB, and your email address.
 - Students must register for a BC Government account, a **BCeID**, and log-in to StudentTranscripts Service using their BCeID.

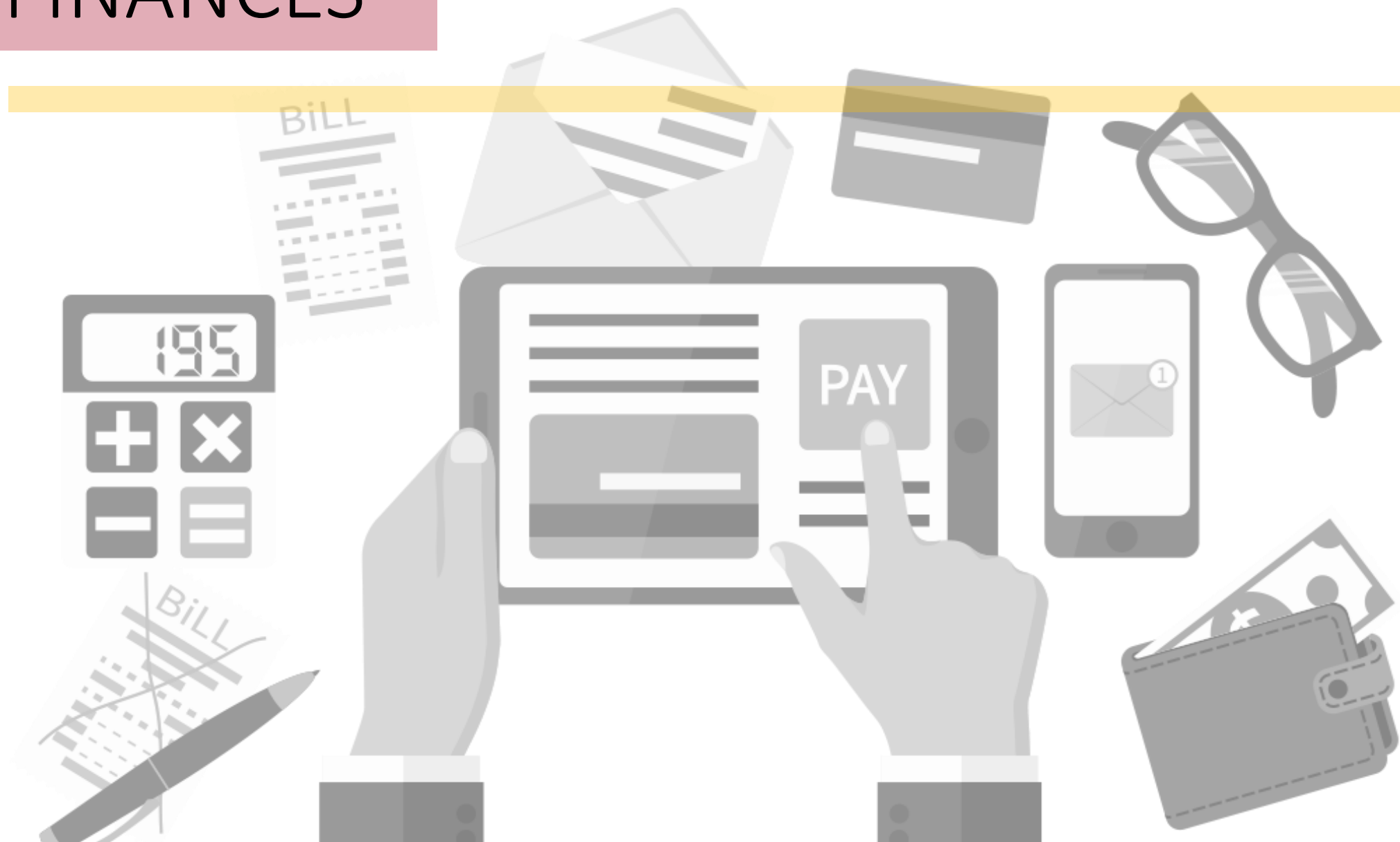

FINANCES



TUITION BREAKDOWN

- **University**

- Approximately \$8 to \$10,000 per year plus books, student fees
- Living on campus will increase your costs by another \$6 to \$8,000

- **College**

- Approximately \$2 to \$4,000 per year for University transfer courses
- Career programs costs will vary according to the program
- 4 year Nursing program costs \$30,000 at Kwantlen

- **Technical Institute**

- Approximately \$6000 per year for a 2 year diploma
- Approximately \$3400 for a 3-6 month certificate
- Approximately \$5580 for a 7-12 month certificate
- Approximately \$830 for a 6 week apprenticeship training
- Approximately \$6700 for a full time degree program





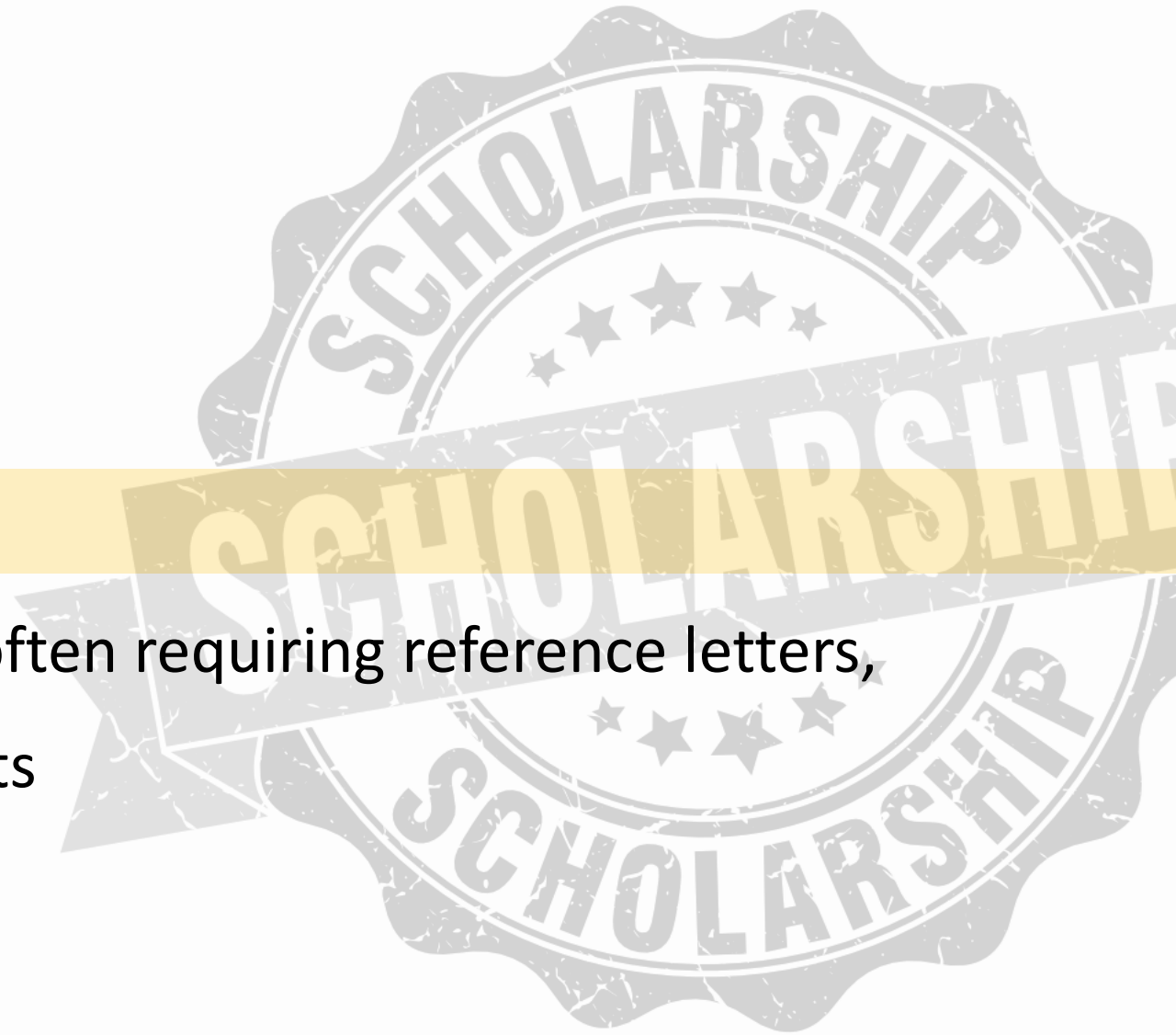

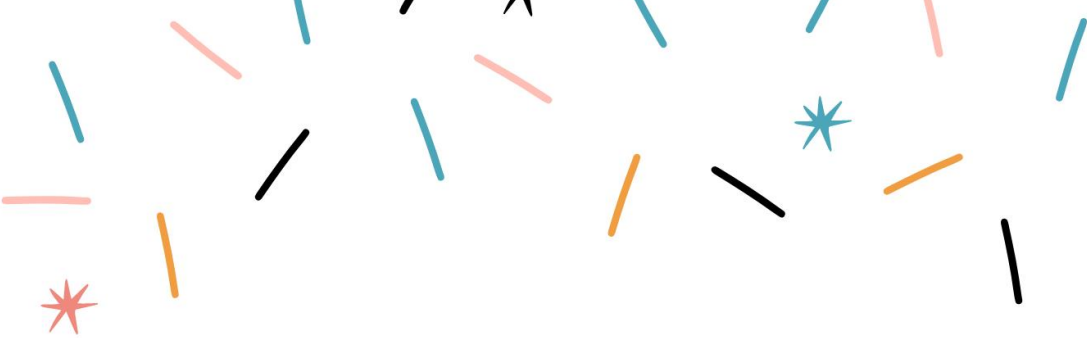
