- 3. Physical Activity (Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics. A project that spans a 1-year period and that is beyond the scope of the physical education class or participation in extracurricular or community level activities)
- 4.International Languages -with IRPs or External Assessments, including AP and IB (must be a creative, practical application of the language and must be an original piece of work)
- 5. Community Service (Volunteer activity, which includes awareness of local, global, and cultural issues)
- 6.Indigenous Languages & Culture (demonstrated at school or in the community)




Numeracy and Literacy Assessments

Students in BC must complete three assessments as part of the graduation program. Students will take the Numeracy 10 assessment and the Literacy 10 assessment in grade 10. Students will also need to take the Literacy 12 assessment in grade 12. We have just completed the first sitting of these assessments. Make up sessions will take place the week of January 23rd, 2023. If you have a grade 12 student is very important to check that they have completed the 2 grade 10 assessments and are scheduled to complete their grade 12 assessment with their English Studies 12 class. Students can check with their counselor to ensure they have met these requirements.
